Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Procedures specified in the Procurement Act 2003 and is open to all Bidders subject to provisions of Section III (Eligible Countries) of the Bid Document.

Interested Bidders may inspect the Bidding Document(s) and obtain further information from the Finance Department, Ministry of Home Affairs, 6 Brickdam Stabroek, Georgetown, Telephone No. 225-4353 between 08:00 hours and 15:30 hours, Monday to Friday.

Bid Documents can be uplifted from the Finance Department, Ministry of Home Affairs, Lot 6 Brickdam Stabroek, Georgetown upon payment of a non refundable fee of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars in favour of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, for each Bid Document. The method of payment shall be in cash or Manager's Cheque.

Bids shall be submitted in a plain sealed envelope bearing no identification of the Bidder. Each envelope should state clearly the name of the project (**for example, 'Capital Works – Construction of Trade Shop, Lusignan Prison, E.C.D, Region # 6, Guyana Police Force, Ministry of Home Affairs**) at the top left hand corner.

Bids will be opened at **09:00 hours on 4th June, 2012** in the Boardroom of the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance in the presence of those Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend the opening.

All Bids must be accompanied by valid Certificates of Compliance from the Manager of the National Insurance Scheme (NIS) and the Commissioner General of the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA).

Each bid that exceeds fifteen million dollars (G\$15M) must be accompanied with bid securities as stated in bid Documents.

The National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and not necessarily to award to the lowest Bid.
