Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Procedures specified in the Procurement Act 2003 and is open to all Bidders subject to provisions of Section III (Eligible Countries) of the Bid Document.

Bid Documents can be uplifted from the Finance Department, Ministry of Home Affairs, Lot 6 Brickdam Stabroek, Georgetown upon payment of a non refundable fee of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars in favour of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, for each Bid Document. The method of payment shall be in Cash or Manager's Cheque.

Bids shall be submitted in a plain sealed envelope bearing no identification of the Bidder. Each envelope should state clearly the name of the project (**for example, 'Buildings – Rehabilitation Works to Living Quarters – Mounted Branch Compound, Kingston, Georgetown, Guyana Police Force, Ministry of Home Affairs**) at the top left hand corner.

Bids will be opened at **0900 hours on 18th June, 2013** in the Boardroom of the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance in the presence of those Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend the opening.

All Bids must be accompanied by valid Certificates of Compliance from the Manager of the National Insurance Scheme (NIS) and the Commissioner General of the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA).

The National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and not necessarily to award to the lowest Bid.
