

The Ministry of Home Affairs has noted with consternation statements attributed to Tacuma Ogunseye at a meeting held on Saturday, April 16, 2011 at Beterverwagting on the East Coast of Demerara.

Excerpts of his statements were published in the Guyana Chronicle of Monday, April 18, 2011 under the headline;

“ACDA reads ‘riot act’ for power sharing if Opposition loses”

Mr Ogunseye is on record for his extremists, pro-violence, divisive and racist outbursts expressed publicly from time to time.

Mr. Ogunseye is known to be associated directly and indirectly with persons who have publicly declared their commitment to remove the extant political order by violent means.

Mr Ogunseye has come to the attention of the Security Forces in Guyana because of statements he has made from time to time threatening the security of the State.

The recent statements purportedly made by Mr. Ogunseye is manifest of criminal intent and racist in context.
